**CONDITIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF RECONDITIONED EMPTY BARRELS
(NOTIFICATION No. RPL/S/ 4829/2012-13 Dt 18.01.2012)**

1. Sealed competitive tenders are invited for the supply of 8500 Nos. once used light duty mild steel 210 litres re-conditioned drums (light weight) for the year 2012-13 to be delivered at L.C.Factory at Abhayagiri in Kulathupuzha Estate and stocking them properly at the site as per instructions, as per the following supply schedule.

2. Tenderers should quote rates for light weight drums only. They should also indicate quantities which they intend to supply.
3. The drums should be thoroughly washed with caustic soda or any other comparable solution followed by water and dried.
4. Barrels previously used for storage of heavy oil, light grease, paint or similar materials should be degreased with petrol or kerosene. Drums previously used for packing of heavy grease should not be supplied.
5. Dust or rust, if any present in the drums should be removed thoroughly.
6. The supplier after thorough cleaning and drying should paint the inside of the drums and inside bottom surface of the bungs with two coats of an alkali resistant bituminous black paint conforming to ISI 158, which is resistant to ammonia preserved latex and which is free from iron, copper or manganese.

The outside of the drums should be painted with two coats of superior enamel paint and specified below:

- a) Body : In post office red colour
- b) Top & Bottom : Golden Yellow Colour

Further the following text is to be stenciled on the middle portion of the barrel in yellow colour as shown below:

Company's emblem, "RPL" (3" width letter)
"An ISO Certified Company " (2" width letter)
" REHAB " (On the other side 3" width letter)

7. Anti-corrosive metallic primer should be applied before painting the body of the barrel.
8. Only after the bituminous paint inside the drums is thoroughly dry, the drums should be supplied. If non-compliance of the above condition results in decolouration or purification of latex filled inside, the loss so sustained by the company will be recovered from the supplier's bill. If that is insufficient, then through legal means/Revenue recovery proceedings.
9. Each light weight drum should have a minimum weight of 17 kgs. and above and the drums should have passed the following test.

Pressure test: All drums when subjected to an internal air pressure of 0.5 to 0.6 kg./cm² (or 7 to 8.4 PSI) for 30 seconds shall not show any sign of leakage

10. The supplier should guarantee against leakage. Drums found leaking even at the time filling will be rejected. A certificate should be sent along with the load that all the barrels are pressure tested.
11. The supplier should stencil the initials of their name on the body of the drums (bottom portion).
12.
 - a) Both big and small bungs should be supplied along with the drums.
 - b) The two big and small openings at the top of each barrel should be quite proper so as to seal the openings with suitable circular caps to prevent pilferage.
13. EMD @ 1% of quoted value in the form of DD payable at **Punalur** drawn in favour of "**Rehabilitation Plantations Ltd.,**" should be attached to each offer. Tenders without EMD are liable to be rejected. Exemption, if any, will be allowed as per government order. Request for adjustment of EMD against any outstanding dues will

14. The tenderer should quote for a minimum quantity of 1000 drums failing which the offer is liable to be rejected. The proposed schedule of supply of the barrels offered may also be shown in the tender.
15. The EMD in respect of the supplier whose offer has been accepted will be retained and adjusted against Security Deposit.
16. The successful tenderer should execute an agreement as per the terms and conditions prescribed by the Company within 7 days from the date of confirmation order. Security Deposit @ 5% of total purchase order should be remitted by DD payable at Punalur before executing the agreement. If the tenderer fails to remit the SD and or execute the agreement, the EMD will be forfeited and the Company will have right to procure the barrels by making alternate arrangements at the risk and loss of the defaulter, and the loss so incurred will be recovered from the tenderer through legal means/Revenue Recovery proceedings.
17. The Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited as liquidated damages in the event of any breach of contract by the supplier.
18. EMD will be refunded within one week of the finalization of contract to all those whose offers have not been accepted.
19. The rate offered should be for one drum for delivery at our said factory. The rates should be inclusive of the transporting charges, taxed applicable and other handling charges.
20. Each consignment of drums will be inspected by the officer in charge of the factory on receipt and drums that do not conform to the above specification will be rejected. The officer in charge of the factory will have the right to reject any drum, at any time as and when a defect is noticed in any of the drums. The supplier will have to remove the rejected drums at his cost from the factory immediately.
21. The successful tenderer should enter into an agreement for the supply of barrels at the quoted rate for the stipulated period. The Company will not consider any increase in rate during the period of agreement.

22. The material supplied by the tenderer should be environmentally safe.
23. The supplier must also enclose a test report of the material supplied at the time of delivery.
24. The material safety data sheet (MSDS) of product supplied must be enclosed wherever applicable.
25. Specific mention must be made if the product supplied contains any toxic/ environmentally hazardous material.
26. All payments of the barrels supplied will be effected by the Head Office of the Company taking into account the stores receipt note issued by the Factory Manager. Any dispute regarding quality/specification of barrels supplied will be referred to Factory Manager whose decision will be binding on the contract.
27. The supply may be effected as per the schedule mentioned in the supply order or as directed by the Factory Manager, Kulathupuzha Estate. In case the supplier, fails to supply the accepted quantity in time during period as per schedule the Company is free to purchase the drums from any other source at the risk and expenses of the supplier, as the loss so sustained will be recovered through legal means/Revenue Recovery proceedings.
28. The Company will not be responsible for any disruption due to force majeure or any other obstruction whatsoever within its estate or factory and the resultant losses, if any, to the supplier.
29. Sealed cover super scribed "OFFER FOR THE SUPPLY OF EMPTY BARRELS 2012-13" containing (a) offers in terms of these conditions of purchase (b) A copy of the conditions of purchase duly signed on each page and (c) EMD, should be addressed to reach the RPL, Punalur before 1.00 p.m. on 16.02.2012 . The offer will be opened at 3.00 p.m. on the same day in the presence of the representatives of intending suppliers. If the date of tender happens to be a holiday, the tender will be held on the next working day at the same time and venue.

30. Post offers received if any, providing for difference in the rates by less than 5% of the lowest quoted rate will not be considered. Post offers received after two days of the date of tender will not also be entertained.
31. There is no undertaking to accept the lowest or any offer and the Company will have absolute discretion to accept or reject any offer partially or in total without assigning any reasons.
32. All suits or other legal proceedings in connection with any of the matters relating to this tender shall be instituted in the courts at Punalur/Kottarakkara.
